The company has been created not just to manufacture machines that make exceptional coffee, it also wants to provide support and raise awareness of mental health within the coffee industry.

Launching with a CSR programme that is focused on supporting local and National charities, Design Espresso has taken the first steps towards strengthening mental health support available in its locality with the development of a partnership with Leicester based charity, Leicester Action for Mental Health Project (LAMP).



Design Espresso and LAMP aim to explore a number of options focused on practical support for those experiencing poor mental health, and providing opportunities to emphasise the power of a conversation through the creation of an over the phone advice and information hub, online wellbeing tips and a mobile 'coffee and chat' offer for businesses.




Why is the new machine called the Ceri 2 group machine?

The purpose behind the new Ceri 2 group machine stems from an incident in 2020 when a member of staff. Ceri. tragically took her own life.
